Prayer was given by Police Chief Jeff Culver and pledge lead by City Clerk Sarah Salmons.

Approval of the agenda was the next item on the agenda. Councilmember Dorothy Sizemore made a motion to approve the agenda with additions added, seconded by Councilmember George Saylor, and vote is as follows:

Introduction of the Mayor's Youth Advisory Council was the next item on the agenda. Councilmember Terry Wilson introduced the members present who were: Hallie Arnett, Jake Roberts, and Jordan Gibson, four other members were absent. Councilmember Terry Wilson explained to the council what the group is designed to do for youth and the community, a round of applause was given by everyone.

Charles House of the Clay County Historical Society came before the council and presented three new historical maps that will be made onto fiberglass and put into the Gazebo that will be out in front of City Hall. The signs included information on Prominent Clay County People, The Civil War in Clay County, and Historic Trails and Places, discussion followed.

The next item on the agenda was the Business Privilege Licenses Ordinance sponsored by Councilmember Dorothy Sizemore, discussion followed. A special called council meeting is scheduled for June 22, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. here at City Hall it will be a working meeting on the Business Privilege Licenses Ordinance.

Mayor Lewis read aloud to the council and audience the Mayor's Budget Address. The address told of everything that has went on in the City as far as projects, grants, and improvements.

The item of Lover's Leap Road was the next item on the agenda which was brought before the council by Councilmember John Ed Pennington. The concern of a rock slide was brought to his attention by a citizen. General Supervisor Mike White informed that the city would have to rent a hammer to bust the rock up to get it removed. Mayor Lewis informed him that it will be taken care of as soon as possible.

Noise complaints in East Manchester were the next item on the agenda brought before the council by Councilmember John Ed Pennington, discussion followed.


Dog control was the next item on the agenda brought to the council by Councilmember George Saylor, discussion followed.

The swinging bridge on Bridge Street was the next item on the agenda brought before the council by Councilmember John Ed Pennington, discussion followed.






